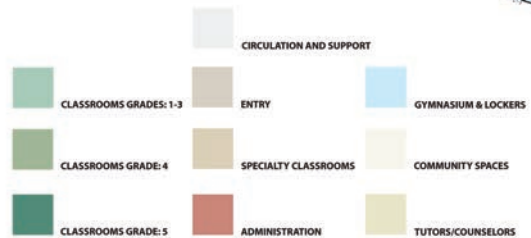


The Carroll School provides a private education to students with learning disabilities. In recent years their student body has grown tremendously; well beyond the capacity available of their main campus in Lincoln Massachusetts. In 2009 the Carroll School purchased a building to house their expanding student body; their new acquisition retained many details reminiscent of its prior life as a nursing home. The project did not involve the addition of any space to the building however it underwent major interior renovations. Walls were demolished and relocated to accommodate larger classrooms and individualized tutoring spaces. Flooring was replaced throughout the building; each classroom includes a wet and dry zone. The once bland corridor is now animated with colorful stops along its length providing sitting/reading areas directly outside of the classrooms. With the addition of new glass doors and interior windows the entry provides continuous views throughout the administrative area. The project was completed by the beginning of the 2010 school year.
